Description: The course is a **comprehensive training course** and includes EMG, neurography and related techniques.

Language: English

Participants: The participants are expected to have basic knowledge in the field of EMG and neurography. The course will be of interest for clinical neurophysiologists in training (part of the Swedish residency program, LIPUS certified SK-kurs), neurologists and for those referring patients to the EMG lab such as pediatric neurologists and medical rehabilitation physicians.

Course topics:

- Principles, recording and analysis methods of neurography, EMG as well as methods to study neuromuscular transmission failure.
- Indications, strategies and typical findings of electrodiagnostic studies in neuromuscular disorders as well as pediatric aspects of clinical neurophysiology.
- Interpretation of findings as well as sources of error regarding neurophysiological methods of the peripheral nervous system.
